

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE

In order to expedite all membership applications we request that the following basic steps are adhered to;

APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP: THROUGH A PROPOSER

- a. The proposer must ensure the membership application form is completed providing all relevant details and is dated.
- b. The application form must be signed by; the proposer, a seconder and the applicant.
- c. The proposer and seconder must be members of the section the applicant is applying to join. No committee member or spouse may propose or second an applicant.
- d. A clearance letter from the applicant's previous club, if applicable, must be attached.
- e. The proposer is to ensure that the new member is integrated into the Club after acceptance.

APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP: WITHOUT A PROPOSER.

- a. A membership application form must be completed providing all relevant details and be dated and signed.
- b. A letter of reference from the applicant's employer/company must accompany the application form.
- c. A clearance letter from previous club, if applicable, must be attached.

GENERAL

- a. Applications for all sections will be posted on the Club's notice board for a period of thirty (30) days from date of receipt of the application form.
- b. Golf membership applicants may only play on time sheet times once they have an official handicap of 24 or less for men and 36 or less for ladies.
- c. New members joining Killarney Country Club who wish to make use of the clubs facilities immediately upon handing in their membership application forms and payment, may do so on the understanding that their status as a member of the club will only become official after the expiry of the thirty (30) day notice board posting period. Should an objection be raised regarding their acceptance as a member, the applicant will be notified immediately of their non-acceptance as a member and reimbursed accordingly. In the event of an objection being raised against a golfing member on Unlimited Golf and who has already made use of the golfing facilities, such member shall be liable for all costs incurred during this period.
